## Forms & Gears to supply fixtures to Cummins

Chennai: Cummins India, as part of its ongoing technology upgradation and capacity expansion, has awarded a multicrore contract to Chennai-based Forms and Gears to design and manufacture precision hydraulically clamped test cells and test carts. These are high precision devices on which the Cummins 16 and 12 cylinder Vtype engines are mounted and tested for performance.
